TISC Networks

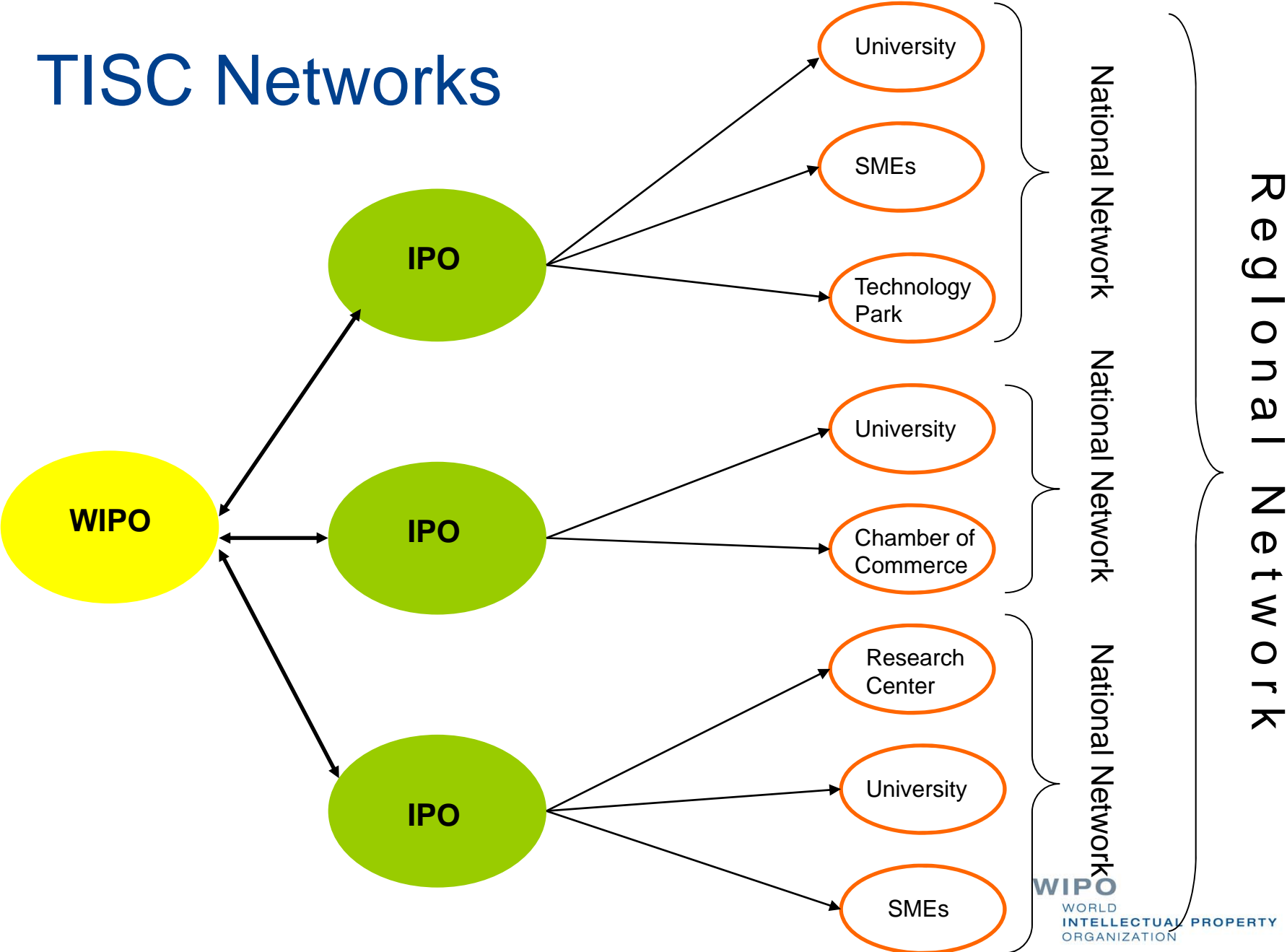
■ National Network

- Regional conferences
